

COASTLANDS BIBLE READING PLAN: JULY 2026

The Gospel of Mark was written in Rome by John Mark (who was closely associated with the apostle Peter) to encourage Roman Christians at a time of intense persecution. The book is fast moving, with an emphasis on facts and action rather than themes or topics, and is the shortest, although often more detailed, of the four Gospels. It is concise, straightforward and chronological, written to prove beyond doubt that Jesus is the Messiah and showing Jesus 'on the move' revealing his identity by what he does, as much as what he says.
