

# COASTLANDS BIBLE READING PLAN: MARCH 2026

Corinth was a large, prosperous and cosmopolitan port city in the Roman world. It had a real mix of cultures and beliefs. Paul wrote this letter to address specific problems in the church that he had established eighteen months previously before moving on to other cities. His responses which are in line with parts of the Gospel story underline how we as Christians need to live out what we say we believe. Some lifestyle attitudes and cultural conduct will seem alien to us as 21<sup>st</sup> century readers, so be sure to focus on the TRUTHS which are so wonderfully explained.
